





WORLD CEMENT EXPORT IN Q1 (MILLION \$)






WORLD CEMENT EXPORT BY COUNTRY IN Q1 (1000 TON)



WORLD CEMENT IMPORT BY COUNTRY IN Q1 (MILLION \$)





WORLD CEMENT IMPORT BY COUNTRY IN Q1 (1000 TON)







WORLD CLINKER EXPORT BY COUNTRY IN Q1 (MILLION \$)






WORLD CLINKER EXPORT BY COUNTRY IN Q1 (1000 TON)



WORLD CLINKER IMPORT BY COUNTRY IN Q1 (1000 \$)





WORLD CLINKER IMPORT BY COUNTRY IN Q1 (1000 TON)












CEMENT EXPORT OF TURKEY BY COUNTRY

CLINKER EXPORT OF TURKEY BY COUNTRY





It is predicted that the industry's consumption will not grow in 2020 and the global cement consumption will remain at 4 billion tons with a limited contraction of 0.1 percent annually. It is estimated that global cement demand, excluding China, will reach 1.9 billion tons with an annual increase of 3.6 percent.



WORLD CEMENT INDUSTRY OUTLOOK FOR THE NEAR FUTURE

1	As of 2019, cement is produced in 9 out of every 10 countries. In parallel with consumption, global cement production has reached 4 billion tons in 2019 with a 3.2 percent growth in 2018, following an annual contraction of approximately 2 percent in 2018.
2	While the global cement production capacity has increased by approx. 60% in the last 10 years, the increase in the global demand for cement demand has been limited to 20%. Global average cement capacity utilization rates, which approached 80 percent 10 years ago, are below 60 percent today.
3	Capacity disposals, mergers and acquisitions aimed at improving return on investments and overall financial indicators have become global industry trends in the cement industry.
4	During the period between 2017-2019, global cement and clinker exports increased by an average of 6.8% annually, reaching approximately 211 million tons. The top 20 exporting countries alone account for 87% of total global cement and clinker exports.


